

Children's Program

This program is for ages 18 months and up. It provides a nurturing introduction to dance by instilling a love for the art and teaches tools for success as the student progresses. Simply stated, this is where a dancer "learns how to learn."

Attendance

Regular attendance of classes is essential in order to progress. Missed classes may be made up if there is an appropriate class available (same level or lower).

Late Pickup Policy

All dancers must be picked up immediately after class. BVI has a late pick up fee of \$10 for every 15 minutes a student is picked up late. Parents are asked to be especially timely when their child's class is the last class of the day. BVI assumes no responsibility or liability for any dancer during breaks from classes or rehearsals inside or outside of the BVI facility.

Class Placement

Upon taking a placement class, students will be placed in a level of instruction best suited to their abilities. Advancement is considered on an individual basis. Considerations often include a student's physical development with regard to injury prevention. Students progress at their own rate and should be rewarded for their own personal achievements without comparison to other students.

Private Lessons

Private lessons are \$60 per hour to instructor. Semi-private lessons (2-3 dancers) are \$50 per dancer paid to instructor. In addition, there is a \$10 per hour studio rental fee paid to BVI. Payment is due at time of lesson.

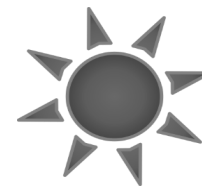

Dance w/ Me & Adaptive Dance w/Me (includes parent and child) - one 45 min. class

\$100 for full 6-week session

Pre-Ballet—one 45 min. class

*\$15 per week OR \$90 for full 6-week session

Beginning Ballet, Ballet A, Ballet B and Bridge—one 1 hour class

*\$16 per week OR \$96 for full 6-week session

Beginning Tap - 1 hour class

*\$16 per week OR \$96 for full 6-week session

Two classes per week

*\$29 per week OR \$174 for full 6 week session

*This option is for those registering for less than six weeks.

WITHDRAWAL/REFUND POLICY

BVI must receive a completed, official BVI withdrawal form 30 days prior to a release from tuition obligations. Refunds will not be made, except in the case of serious illness or injury, verified by a doctor's certificate. If a student is dismissed from the academy because of unacceptable behavior, no tuition will be refunded. BVI reserves the right to deny any refund request. Should a tuition refund be issued, the registration fee will not be refunded.

DRESS CODE

Students must wear the dress code for their level. Leotard styles allowed are spaghetti strap, tank top, long sleeve, short sleeve and cap sleeve; no crisscross back straps, rhinestones, mesh or lace inserts are permitted. Hair must be in a bun and off the face. The only jewelry permitted is stud earrings. All students must maintain a neat appearance. Students of all ages should wear clothing over their dance attire when outside of BVI. Dance shoes should never be worn on outside surfaces.

Dance with Me: Any color leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes. Skirts or tutus optional

Pre-Ballet, Beginning Ballet, Ballet A, B and Beginning Tap: Light blue leotard (no attached skirt), pink tights, pink ballet shoes, hair in a classical ballet bun. Black tap shoes if registered for a tap class.

Boys: White tee, black shorts or leggings, white socks and black ballet shoes .
